

GO 50+



NEW Year's fitness resolutions just got more affordable for Howard County's senior residents.

Monday, officials announced a **new program called Go 50+**, which offers membership to all the county's fitness centers to adults 50 years and older for a flat annual fee.

For \$75 a year, Howard County's older adults can gain access to fitness facilities at all Howard County 50+ Centers as well as the North Laurel Community Center, the Roger Carter Community Center in Ellicott City and the Gary J. Arthur Community Center in Glenwood. For pool access, residents can pay \$175 annually.

The program is also open to non-residents, at a fee of \$100 a year for the fitness plan or \$225 for the fitness and pool package.
