In the Budget



The County Council began the budget review process this month and will vote on a final budget in May. Jon has worked to make sure appropriate funding is

budgeted for major District 1 projects including the new Elkrigde Library and 50+ Center (including a temporary site) and the new Elkrigde Fire Station. Other budget highlights for District 1 include:

- **Sidewalks on Montgomery Road by Elkrigde Elementary/Elkrigde Landing Middle schools**, with the potential of extending the sidewalk to Route 1.
- **Funds for the Historic Ellicott City** to address flooding, improve bicycle-friendliness, and support the EC Partnership and its continued efforts.
- **Funds for the Patapsco Heritage Greenway** and their efforts in historic Elkrigde and Ellicott City.
- **Sidewalk leading to Northfield ES** and Dunloggin MS along Northfield Road.
