**HOWARD COUNTY TO WIT:**

The Chairman called the session to order at 5:30 p.m..

Mary Kay Sigaty, Chairperson; Jennifer Terrasa, Vice Chairperson; and Calvin Ball, Council Member; were present. Council Member Greg Fox participated via conference call. Council Member Courtney Watson was not in attendance.

Stephen LeGendre, Administrator to the County Council; Jim Vannoy, Office of Law; and Jennifer Sager, Legislative Coordinator, were also present.

**FINAL CONSIDERATION**

Council Bill No. 49-2009 – Amending the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance of Howard County, Fiscal Year 2010 in order to make an emergency appropriation from revenues not anticipated in the budget for Fiscal Year 2010

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The Chairperson moved to adopt Council Bill No. 49-2009. The motion was seconded by Ms. Terrasa.

The Chairperson moved to adopt Amendment No. 1 to Council Bill No. 49-2009 as follows: *(This amendment clarifies that any reference in the Fiscal Year 2010 budget to total General Fund Revenues or total General Fund Expenditures shall be a certain amount.)*

On page 2, in line 28, insert:

*“5. In the attachment to Council Bill No. 25-2009, the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance of Howard County, Fiscal 2010, strike “\$820,224,970” and substitute “\$820,334,970” for any other reference to total General Fund Revenues or total General Fund Expenditures.”.*

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The motion was seconded by Ms. Terrasa.

The roll call vote called by the Chairperson on the amendment was: Yea: Council Members Sigaty, Ball, Fox (via conference call) and Terrasa; Absent: Council Member Watson. Amendment No. 1 to Council Bill No. 49-2009 passed.
