Ms. Staton opened the meeting at 4:10 p.m. and welcomed everyone.

The Commissioners approved with specified changes the minutes of the Commission's September 30, 2021 meeting.

Ms. Staton invited members to present draft maps for discussion.

Mr. Marker presented two maps (See attached Maps A and B).

Mr. Serrano presented two maps (See attached Maps C and D).

A discussion immediately followed the presentation of each individual map.

At the conclusion of the presentations, Ms. Staton proposed, and the Commission unanimously agreed, to present for public comment four maps rather than the maximum of three contemplated by the work plan.
