TO ALL LICENSEES:

As you know, the State of Maryland continues to be under a State of Emergency and pursuant to Executive Orders issued by the Governor and County Executive, the liquor license expiration dates continue to be suspended as well as the deadline to submit renewal applications. Most licensees did, however, submit renewal applications for 2020-2021 and were issued current liquor licenses.

Attached is the renewal application and instructions for 2021-2022. We recommend that you submit your renewal application for 2021-2022 by the end of March or as soon as possible thereafter. If you wait until the State of Emergency is lifted, you will only have 30 days to submit your renewal application and fee and receive your liquor license.

**PLEASE NOTE:** If you are not operating at this time, you are subject to Rule 4.02 of the Rules of the Howard County Board of License Commissioners, which states: "if a license holder closes the business for a period of more than 10 days, the license holder shall so inform the Board in writing immediately upon closing."

Please include your e-mail on the application (legibly) as next year we will be contacting you by **email only** concerning renewal information.

For those that **did not** submit a renewal application 2020-2021, please understand that your renewal fee for the year 2020-2021 is still due along with your renewal fee for 2021-2022. If you have any questions, please contact our office at 410-313-2395.
