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**DECISION AND ORDER**

The Board of License Commissioners for Howard County, Maryland (the “Liquor Board”), pursuant to Rule 1.02(A) of the Liquor Board Rules and Regulations, has delegated the authority to hear and decide cases to the Alcoholic Beverage Hearing Board for Howard County, Maryland (the “Hearing Board”).

On August 8, 2017, the Hearing Board heard the application of Ozgun Caglar Deniz (the “Applicant”) on behalf of 9400 Snowden River, LLC, t/a HomeSlyce (“HomeSlyce”), for an extension of premises on their Class B Beer, Wine, and Liquor 7-day on-sale license, from a 3,000 square foot restaurant to a 4,400 square foot restaurant located at 9400 Snowden River Parkway, Suite 126-128, Columbia, MD 21045.

The hearing was properly advertised and the premises posted pursuant to the Alcoholic Beverages Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland. The Applicant was represented by Andrew Hurdle, Esquire. There were no protestants who appeared in opposition to the application.

All the documents on file were incorporated into the record by reference.

## **SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY**

Ozgun Caglar Deniz, 100% shareholder of HomeSlyce, was sworn and testified that he is requesting an extension of premises to expand the restaurant to add 42 seats, a small bocce ball area, ski ball, a pool table, a viewing bar and an additional bathroom. There will be three entrances going into the new area. Mr. Deniz testified that the menu and operations will remain the same and that at least two servers, who are alcohol awareness certified, will be on site at all times. He testified that there have been no previous violations or revocations at this location. Mr. Deniz testified that he will continue to follow the rules and regulations of the Board.

Based on the evidence presented at the hearing, the Alcoholic Beverage Hearing Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law:

### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. The Hearing Board finds that Ozgun Caglar Deniz on behalf of 9400 Snowden River, LLC, t/a HomeSlyce, has applied for an extension of premises on the Class B Beer, Wine, and Liquor 7-day on-sale license from a 3,000 square foot restaurant to a 4,400 square-foot restaurant located at 9400 Snowden River Parkway, Suite 126-128, Columbia, MD 21045.
2. The Hearing Board finds that the Applicant is a fit and proper person to hold an alcoholic beverage license.
3. The Hearing Board finds that Ozgun Caglar Deniz has been a Howard County resident for more than two years, is a registered voter, and 100% shareholder of 9400

Snowden River, LLC, t/a HomeSlyce.

4. The Hearing Board finds that the granting of the application is necessary for the accommodation of the public.

5. The Hearing Board finds that the granting of the application will not unduly disturb the peace and safety of the residents of the neighborhood.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. The Hearing Board concludes that Ozgun Caglar Deniz on behalf of 9400 Snowden River, LLC, t/a HomeSlyce, has applied for an extension of premises on the Class B Beer, Wine, and Liquor 7-day on-sale license from a 3,000 square foot restaurant to a 4,400 square foot restaurant located at 9400 Snowden River Parkway, Suite 126-128, Columbia, MD 21045.

2. The Hearing Board concludes that the Applicant is a fit and proper person to hold an alcoholic beverage license.

3. The Hearing Board concludes that Ozgun Caglar Deniz meets the requirements of Rules 1.10(T), 1.10(U), 2.06, and 2.10 of the Liquor Board Rules and Regulations concerning resident agent qualifications.

4. The Hearing Board concludes that the granting of the application is necessary for the accommodation of the public.

5. The Hearing Board concludes that the granting of the application would not unduly disturb the peace and safety of the neighborhood.

**ORDER**


For the foregoing reasons, it is this 19<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2017, by the Alcoholic Beverage Hearing Board of Howard County **ORDERED** that the application of Ozgun Caglar Deniz on behalf of 9400 Snowden River, LLC, t/a HomeSlyce, for an extension of premises on the Class B Beer, Wine, and Liquor 7-day on-sale license, from a 3,000 square-foot restaurant to a 4,400 square-foot restaurant, located at 9400 Snowden River Parkway, Suite 126-128, Columbia, MD 21045, be and the same is hereby **GRANTED**, subject to the following conditions:


- (a) That the Applicants comply with all State and County laws and regulations; and
- (b) That the Applicants satisfy any requirements necessary to obtain the license by January 30, 2017, unless that deadline is extended by the Board upon good cause shown; and
- (c) Failure to comply with these conditions shall render this Proposed Decision and Order null and void.


