
David Moore, Senior Assistant County Solicitor, represented DILP. Steven Preller, Esquire, represented CBI Homes Inc.


ORDERED, that the Motion to Dismiss Appeal is **GRANTED**, and the Appellant's appeal is hereby **DISMISSED**.






