ORDER

The Howard County Board of Appeals convened on August 27, 2015 to hear arguments and to deliberate regarding the Motion to Dismiss filed by Joan M. Becker, Esq., on behalf of opponents to the above-captioned petition, and on December 9, 2015, held a work session in this same matter, Board of Appeals Case No. BA 13-033C. During the work session, Board Member James Walsh made a Motion to Dismiss the Petition for a Conditional Use filed by Petitioner Al Huda, and two appeals of the Hearing Examiner's ruling on that Petition, one filed by Al Huda and one by Ms. Becker's clients.

Upon review of Mr. Walsh's Motion to Dismiss, it is, this 11th day of February, 2016, by the Howard County Board of Appeals, hereby


ORDERED, that the Motion to Dismiss is granted and the petition for a conditional use filed by Al Huda, Inc. t/a Dar-us-Salam, as well as both appeals of the Hearing Examiner's ruling on that Petition, are dismissed because the Petitioner no longer has the necessary interest in or connection to the subject property.


