### Mulch processing, storage and sales

- permitted subject to special-exception regulations in AG Agricultural District.

Mulch processing, storage and sales. These uses may be granted in the AG district, provided that:

- (a) A minimum parcel area of 10 acres is required.
- (b) Storage areas are fully buffered from view of public roads and neighboring residences by means of a solid fence or wall at least 8 feet high.
- (c) A type "E" buffer yard (see §267-30 Buffer Yards) shall be provided along any adjacent road right-of-way or adjacent property.
- (d) No wood products shall be piled more than 6 feet high or above the level of the buffering, whichever is greater.

- permitted in CI Commercial Industrial District and GI General Industrial District

### Sawmills, firewood processing and distribution.

These uses may be granted in the AG Agricultural District and B3 General Business District., provided that:

- (a) A minimum parcel area of 10 acres is required.
- (b) Storage areas are fully buffered from view of public roads and neighboring residences by means of a solid fence or wall at least 8 feet high.
- (c) A type "E" buffer yard (see §267-30 (Buffer Yards)) shall be provided along any adjacent road right-of-way or adjacent property.
- (d) No wood products shall be piled more than 6 feet high or above the level of the buffering, whichever is greater.
