Council to Hold Issue Briefings with Community Stakeholders

Ellicott City, MD – The Howard County Council is convening a series of issue briefing sessions with community stakeholders. Each session will begin with short presentations by a panel of representatives from government agencies and partner organizations. The presentations will be followed by questions from Council Members and discussion between the panel and Council.

Panelists for this session will include representatives from the Office of Transportation, Multimodal Transportation Board, Bicycle Advisory Group, Pedestrian and Transit Advisory Group, and the Horizon Foundation.
