1	WHEREAS, the Howard County Charter requires the County Council of Howard
2	County to establish a Charter Review Commission ("Commission") every eight years; and

4	WHEREAS, the Commission last convened in 2003; and

6	WHEREAS, the Commission's purpose shall be to ensure that the Charter is clear
7	in meaning, addresses the needs of contemporary government, and remains a functional,
8	working document that effectively outlines the framework for an efficient operation of
9	county government; and

11	WHEREAS, the Council has selected fifteen residents of Howard County to serve
12	as members of the Commission, five of whom have been selected from a list of names
13	submitted by the County Executive, and no more than ten of whom are of the same political
14	party.

16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Howard
17	County, Maryland this day of, 2011 that there is hereby established a
18	Charter Review Commission to review the Charter, to identify sections of the current
19	Charter that need to be revised, and to recommend changes for consideration.

30	recommendations and drafts of recommended revisions of the Charter.

exceed 2 years.
AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commission shall establish a
schedule of public hearings to be held at various locations in the County.
AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commission shall conduct
meetings in accordance with the Maryland Open Meetings Law.
AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any vacancies on the Commission
shall be filled by the Council.
AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all recommendations and proposed
Charter revisions shall be approved by a majority of the Commission members before they
are forwarded to the Council.
AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that minority reports of the Commission
may also be forwarded to the Council for consideration.
AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commission shall adopt rules of
procedure to accomplish its charges as set forth in this Resolution.
