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Other Comments:

The Bureau of Environmental Services provided the following list of stream restoration projects currently in process. Application of Council Bill 40-2023 to these projects will be governed by Section 16.102(h) of the County Code:

**County Projects, through Stormwater Management Division:**

- Cherrytree Farm 1/2 Pond Retrofit Project
  - This will stabilize a small segment of stream at the outfall of the pond repair project.
- Sucker Branch Stream Stabilization
  - This project is to stabilize the stream along a new sanitary pipe alignment.
- Dunloggin at Plumtree Branch
  - The design currently under re-review.
- Woodland Road Stream Stabilization
  - Construction will probably start in a month or two to stabilize the stream along a recently completed sanitary sewer project.
- Woodmark Pond Repair and Stream Stabilization
  - This project aims to stabilize a segment of stream at the outfall of the pond repair project, including shifting the stream away from the pond.
- Wood Creek Stream Stabilization
  - Construction may start as soon as this winter to stabilize an existing stream that is threatening to undermine adjacent residential building.
- Manors of Oakwood and Autumn Harvest Projects
  - The project has two existing ponds near each other. The County will decommission the upstream pond and create a new stream thread in its place. It will also stabilize a portion of a stream below the second pond outfall.

**Private Projects:**

- Potential Patapsco River Mitigation Bank Project proposed at 14175 Old Frederick Road
  - There has not yet been a formal submission for this project.
