

SUB-WORKGROUP

DRAFT RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Current and Future growing facilities in Howard County to reserve a portion of their sales/inventory for Minority and women owned businesses/ social equity applicants. (Possibly 30%)
- 2. More specific language to the bill/qualifications of a social equity applicant to be more inclusive and specific for many minority groups.
 - a. Lower the 4 year institution standards for Pell Grant from 40% to 25%
 - b. Include language for self qualification for a Pell grant
- 3. Rent support/ a grant that is spread out pay throughout the year to enable support throughout the entire year and not just one time payment.
 - a. At least 6 months to a year.
 - b. EDA partnership for specific cannabis industry
 - c. Implement something similar to the San Francisco Incubator/rent support
