Chair Jung opened the meeting at 10:02 a.m.

Agenda

Police Department

Chief Der gave an introduction and summary of the Departmental operating budget which proposes an approximate 9% overall increase. The Department responded to questions from the Council on officer overtime and future vacancies; the compensation packages that are currently before the Council; the starting salary for officers; timing for the next recruiting class; percentages of budget increases, particularly chargebacks; Non-Departmental expenses for mobile data computers, the indoor firing range, moving costs, and ammunition purchase; the abolishment of positions; recruitment and retention bonuses; speed cameras; school bus camera fund; and Merriweather overtime.

Non-Departmental Expenses

The Administration responded to questions from the Council on how does a request end up on the Non-Departmental list; Boys and Girls club transportation; Child Support pilot program; Climate Action Plan Implementation; Club Wilde Lake; Community Ambassador Program;

Economic Assistance and Emerging Needs program; Environmental Land Banking Program; Equipment purchases; Francis Scott Key Bridge – Economic Impact and Needs; guaranteed Basic Income Pilot Program; Howard County Tourism Council; Howard County EcoWorks; Innovation and Modernization Fund; Reproductive Health Program; Route 1 Redevelopment Initiative; Sheppard Pratt; Shock Trauma funding; Traffic Calming Pilot Program; and Volunteer Fire Stations.

Department of Finance

Director Ighile gave an introduction of the Department and summary of their operating budget. The Department responded to questions from the Council on Grants Writing Non-Departmental expense; Hagerty Consultants; ARPA funding for "Live Where You Work" program; and property tax assessment appeals.

Technology and Communications

Director Mayotte gave a presentation of the Department and summary of their operating budget (7% increase). The Department responded to questions from the Council on GTV; IT Chargeback structural deficit; and costs of software licenses.

Department of Recreation and Parks

Director Mooneyhan gave an introduction of the Department and summary of their operating budget. The Department responded to questions from the Council on negative fund balance; cost of living increases and staffing levels; Recreation Special Services fund, specifically golf; Preschool Camps; Camp Ilchester; and "drop in" programming.

Department of Public Works

Director Kebede gave a presentation of the Department and summary of their operating budget (10% increase). The Department responded to questions from the Council on vacant positions, hiring, and overtime costs; one-time expenses; surplus property; Climate Action Plan; Stormwater ponds and HOAs; Accident Safety Panels; Apprenticeships Programs; Court Expenses; Reclassification study; Sludge; and Morale.

Department of Inspections, Licenses and Permits

Director Frances gave a presentation of the Department and summary of their operating budget. The Department responded to questions from the Council on commercial mechanical inspectors; factors for decrease in inspection times; and plan reviews, and digitizing.

Continuation of General County Capital

Mr. Delorenzo stated that they were still awaiting repricing for the New Cultural Center. Mr. Delorenzo and Emily Metzler then discussed the new TIF model and compared it to last year's

model. The Administration responded to questions from the Council on the TIF revenue changes.

Chair Jung adjourned the meeting at 4:10 p.m.

- . Chair Jung requested the figures of Merriweather overtime.
- Councilmember Yungmann asked for historical funding and name of the current Economic Assistance and Emerging Needs program. Chair Jung would like to know the parameters of the program.
- Chair Jung requested a list of past Innovation and Modernization fund recipients.
- Chair Jung requested for the schedule of when the 16 beds at Sheppard Pratt will be available.
- Council Member Walsh asked that the Youth Engagement Programming Initiatives be expanded to Elkridge.
- Chair Jung and Councilmember Yungmann requested a list of other jurisdictions that have contributed to Shock Trauma.
- Councilmember Rigby asked for a list of the top 5 jurisdictions that use Shock Trauma.
- Chair Jung asked that the Administration reach out to each Councilmember about top priorities for traffic calming.
- Council Member Walsh and Chair Jung requested a written explanation of "Indirect Costs" from Finance.
- Councilmember Jung asked the Department of Finance for a cost for Hagerty consultants.
- Councilmember Jung asked the Department of Finance for details of the Live Where You Work program.
- Chair Jung asked for a copy of the High Ridge property deed from DPW.
- Chair Jung requested a list of Courthouse expenses from DPW.
- Chair Jung requested the dollar amount for DPW's Equity funding from Budget.
