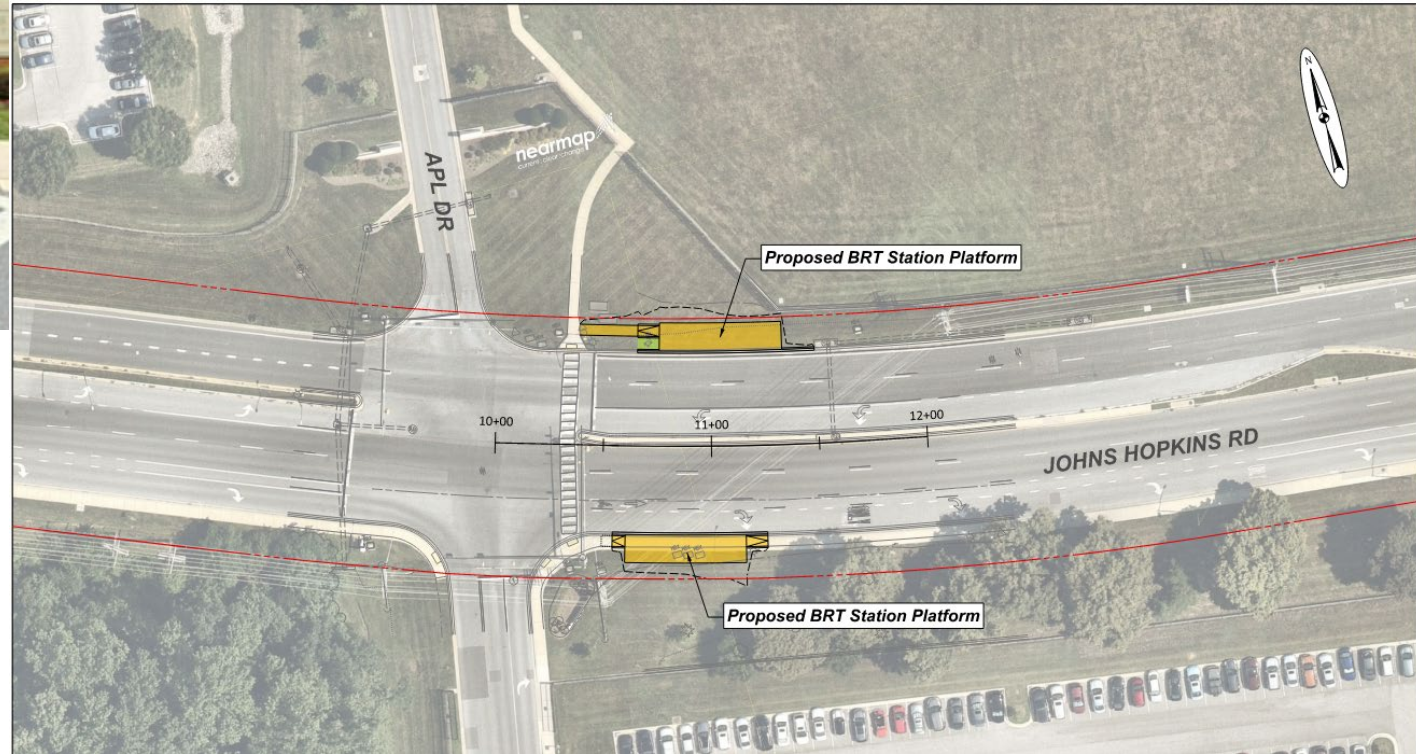

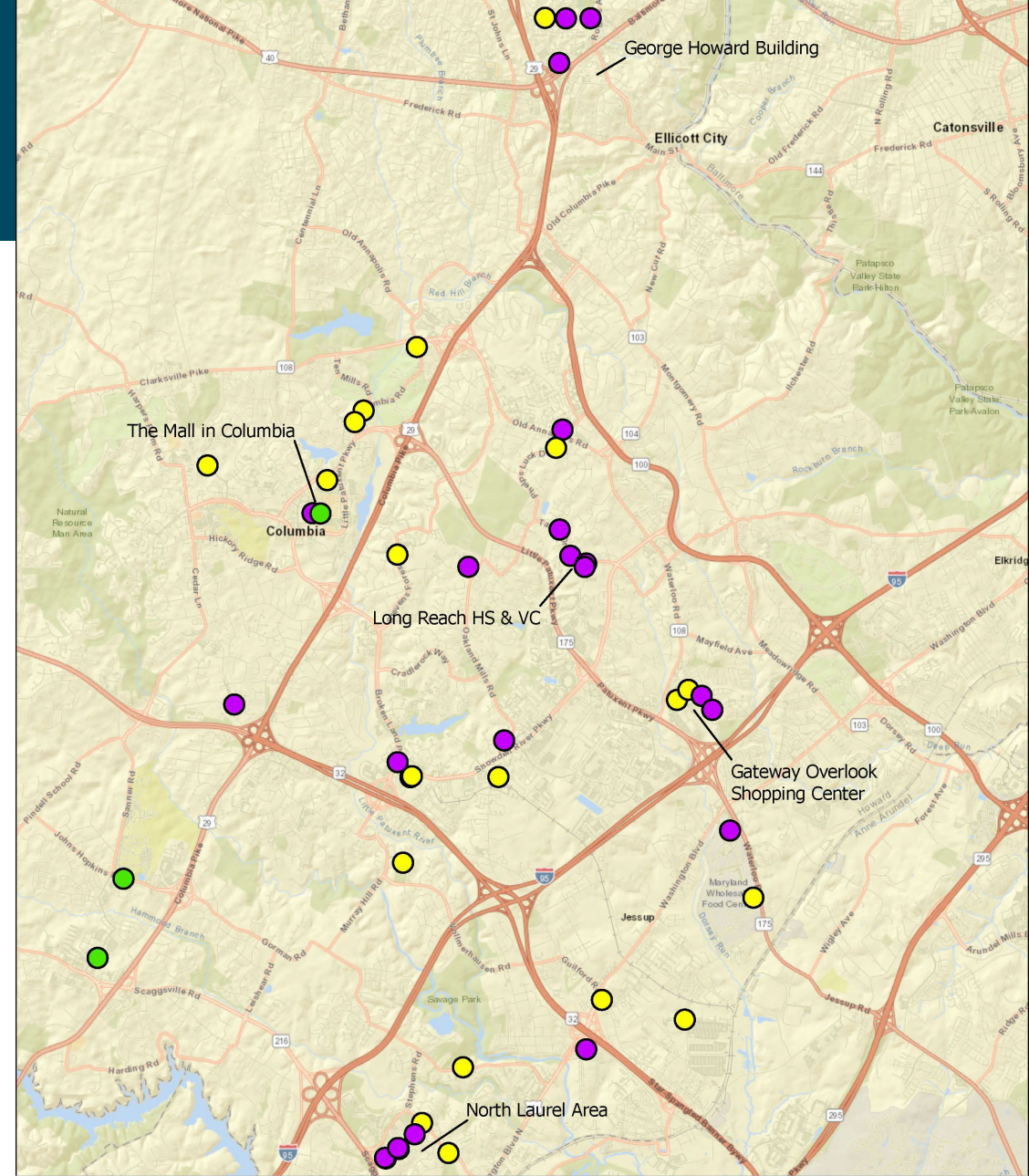
RTA Bus Stops

 - Shelter glass

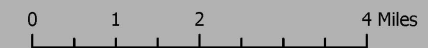
FY 2025

Knee wall makes the stop ADA

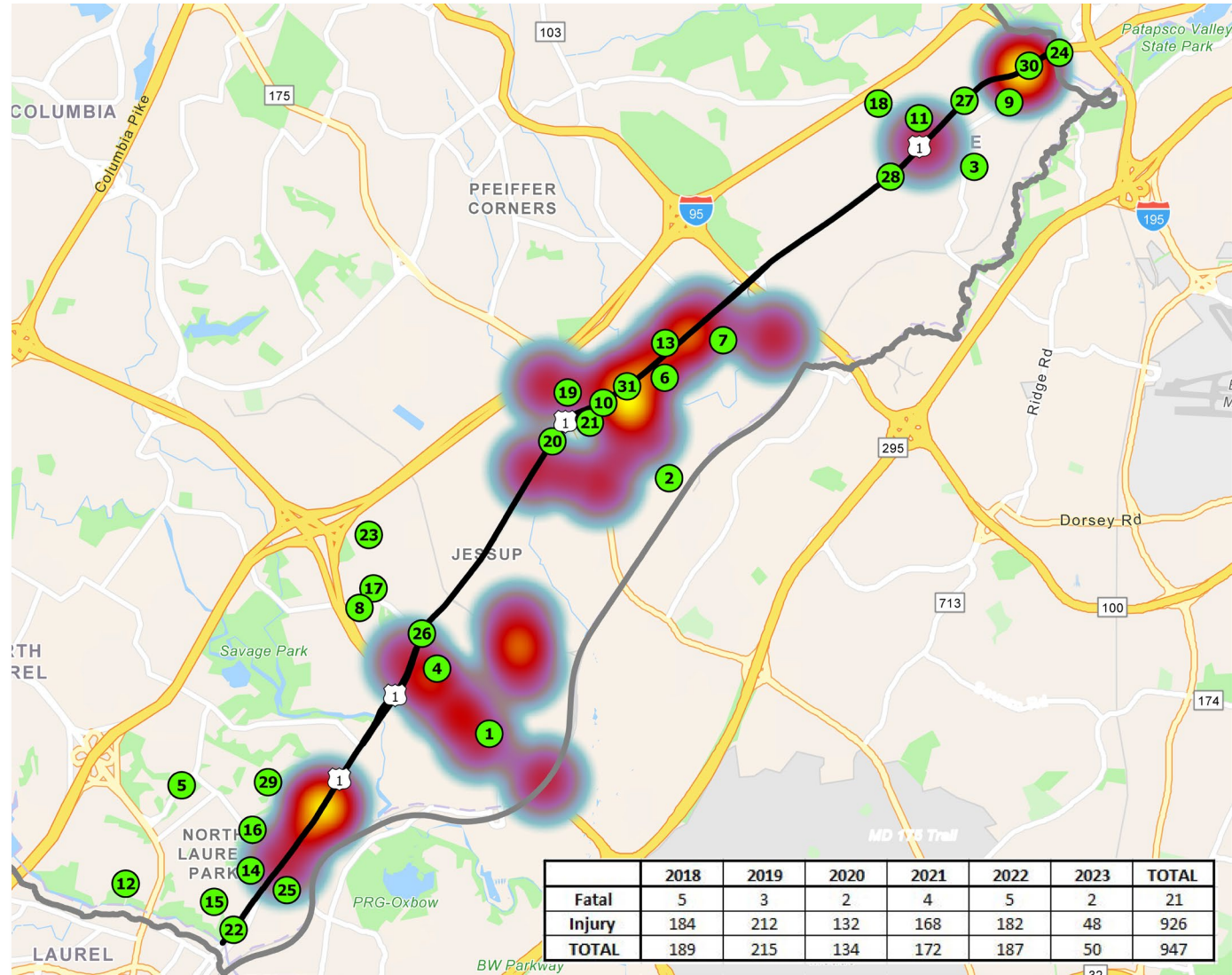
CO353 - DTC Transit Center

- Requesting \$100,000 in FY 2025
- Update the transit center study
- Continue to support efforts to identify and secure a site



C0370 - US 1 Corridor Safe Streets and Roads for All

- To plan, design and implement streetscape, pedestrian, bicycle, transportation and transportation safety improvements in the US 1 Corridor
- Improvements constructed in this project will be delivered by the County either directly or with funding and project partnerships with the private development sector, Maryland Department of Transportation and the US Department of Transportation



C0370 - US 1 Corridor Safe Streets and Roads for All

- Revised to reflect the award of a \$488K federal grant, less than originally requested
- Two Phases
 - Phase 1 - Advance the planning and preliminary design and timely project delivery framework
 - Phase 2 - Return to Safe Streets and Roads For All grant request for construction
