




- Planning for larger scale projects such as new sidewalk construction and connectivity improvements








Foundry St / Washington St (Northbound) – new ADA pad installed

Freetown Rd / Hickory Ridge Village Center – new shelter installed






C0370 - US 1 Corridor Safe Streets and Roads for All
