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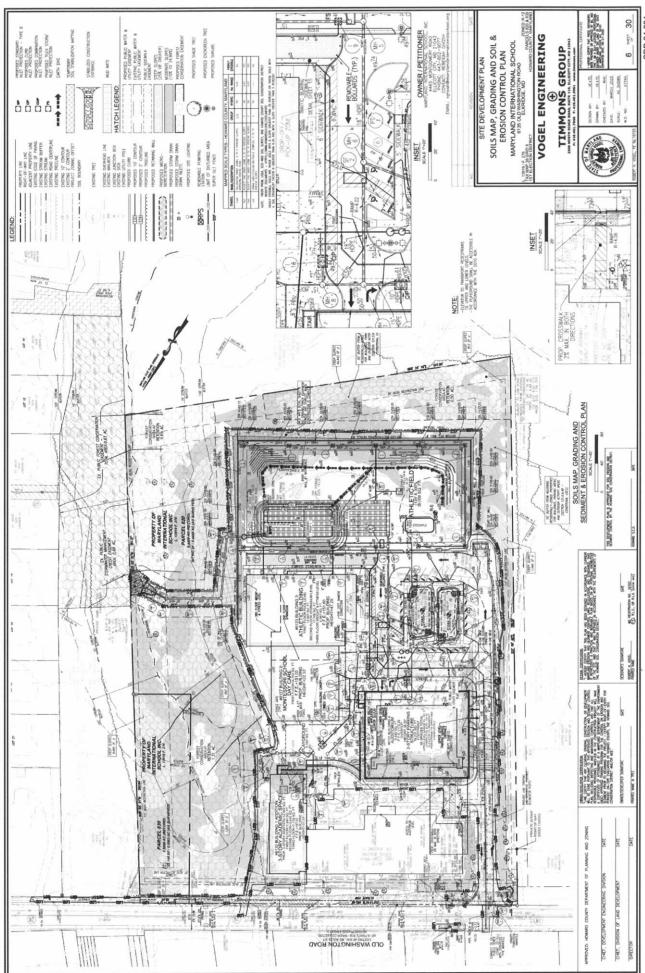
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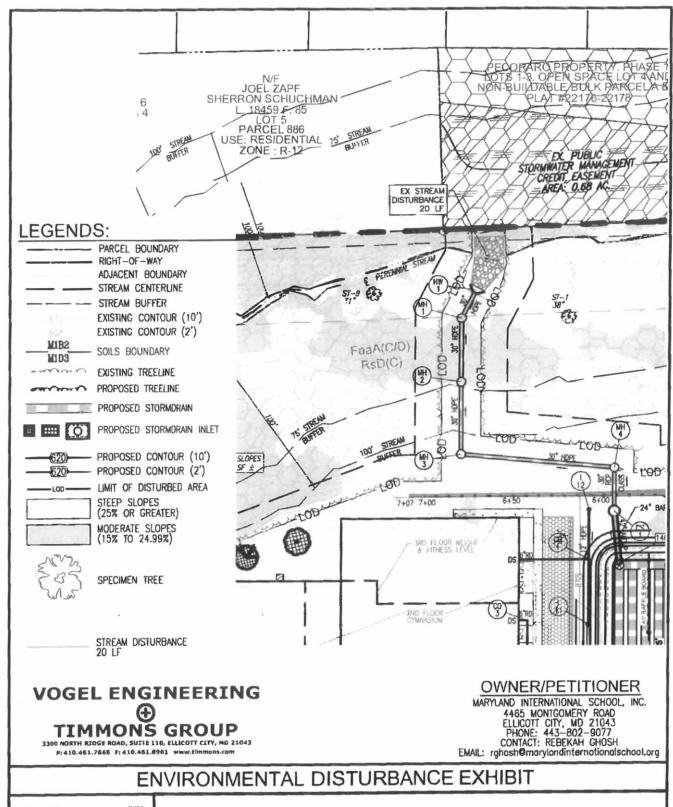

## 1. Appeal Request

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF RULING OR ACTION FROM WHICH THIS APPEAL IS TAKEN:

Appellants are appealing the decision of the Acting Chief of Department of Planning and Zoning ("DPZ") to approve the requests of the Maryland International School, Inc. ("Applicant") for a "request for approval for essential or necessary stream bank, stream buffer, steep slope and 100-year floodplain disturbances associated with the Maryland International School Development" proposed at 6135 Old Washington Rd, Elkridge, MD 21075 ("Subject Property"). DPZ sent notice of the decision on August 14, 2025.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF ERROR OF FACT, OR LAW, IF ANY, PRESENTED BY THIS APPEAL

DPZ failed to adequately articulate its evaluation of all of the required criteria under Section 16.116(c) including the requirement that the proposed disturbance is necessary for "reasonable development of the property" and that "there is no other reasonable alternative." HCZR § 16.116(c)(1). HCZR Section 16.116(c)(2) clarifies that reasonable development does not guarantee maximum possible development and that "achieving the maximum possible density is not sufficient justification alone to allow disturbance."

Moreover, DPZ failed to require, in its decision, environmental remediation, including planting the areas where grading or removal of vegetative cover or trees has taken place utilizing best practices for ecological restoration and water quality enhancement projects." HCZR § 16.116(c)(3). Here, the installation of the proposed outfall will require construction activities in a forested area—requiring the removal of significant amounts of forest and impacts to Specimen Tree, ST-1. DPZ's letter fails to require remediation for any forest removed or the impacts to ST-1.

DPZ also failed to post monthly report including the Applicant's necessary disturbance request on DPZ's website per HCZR Section 16.116(c)(5). As of September 5, 2025, DPZ has only posted reports for January and February of 2025.

Additionally, DPZ's description of the proposed disturbance does not align with the disturbance depicted on the Applicant's SDP drawings. DPZ's letter describes that "the development proposes one outfall extending 20 LF into a 100' priority retention area and 75' stream buffer." However, on the Applicant's most recent SDP drawings, the Applicant depicts that the actual disturbance will be 105 LF, 25 feet wide (25' through the 100'

retention area and 80' through the 75' stream buffer) creating 2,500 square feet of disturbance.

Section 4.2.1 requires DPZ to examine both upstream and downstream impacts for improved channels and requires the County to impose mitigation to remediate any erosive conditions caused by proposed stormwater management facilities. DPZ also failed to adequately study the downstream impacts caused by the proposed stormwater management outfall which will manage storm flows from areas that previously drained to other areas and have been diverted to and concentrated at the proposed outfall which will likely cause downstream erosion. The Applicant also failed to present any evidence that it has or can obtain discharge easement from downstream property owners as Section 1.3 of Howard County's Design Manual, Volume I requires.

Appellants reserve the right to raise additional arguments.

MANNER IN WHICH THE APPELLANT IS AGGRIEVED BY THE RULING OR ACTION

Appellants are adjacent property owners and will be directly impacted by the proposed development with regard to stormwater runoff issues, visual impacts, and their ability to use and enjoy their properties. Moreover, some Appellants live directly downstream of the proposed discharge location.
