Title: AN ACT approving a multi-year collective bargaining agreement between Howard County and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Howard County Local 3080, Council 3, AFL-CIO that will be effective through the end of Fiscal Year 2027 and that includes payment of certain compensation in future fiscal years; approving provisions in a collective bargaining agreement between Howard County and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Howard County Local 3080, Council 3, AFL-CIO, that are in conflict with the provisions of Title 1 "Human Resources" of the Howard County Code or the Employee Manual; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the collective bargaining agreement between Howard County and American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Howard County Local 3080, Council 3, AFL-CIO.

1	WHEREAS, the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees,
2	Howard County Local 3080, Council 3, AFL-CIO ("Local 3080") and the County reached
3	agreement through a Memorandum of Agreement (the "Agreement") that is effective through
4	June 30, 2027; and
5	
6	WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 1.111(e) of the Howard County Code, the
7	County Executive is required to submit to the County Council for its approval all provisions
8	in collective bargaining agreements that are in conflict with Title 1 "Human Resources" of
9	the Howard County Code or the Employee Manual (the "conflicting provisions"); and
10	
11	WHEREAS, the members of Local 3080 have ratified the Agreement, and the
12	Agreement includes provisions that are in conflict with Title 1 of the County Code or the
13	Employee Manual; and
14	
15	WHEREAS, the Agreement includes the amount of compensation to be paid to
16	members of Local 3080 during Fiscal Year 2026 and Fiscal Year 2027; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, the Agreement requires the payment by the County of funds from an
19	appropriation in a later fiscal year and therefore is subject to the multi-year provisions of
20	Section 612 of the Howard County Charter that requires Council approval of the Agreement.
21	
22	NOW, THEREFORE,
23	
24	Section 1. Be It Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland that in
25	accordance with Section 612 of the Howard County Charter, it approves the terms of the
26	Memorandum of Agreement between Howard County, Maryland and the American
27	Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Howard County Local 3080, Council 3,
28	AFL-CIO, as provided in Section 1.606(e) of the Howard County Code, which shall be in
29	substantially the same form as Exhibit 1 attached to this Act.

- 1 **Section 2.** And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland
- 2 that the County Council hereby endorses and ratifies the County Executive's signature and
- 3 execution of the Agreement, which shall be in substantially the same form as Exhibit 1
- 4 attached to this Act, for such term in the name of and on behalf of the County.

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- 6 Section 3. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland
- 7 that, in regard to the Memorandum of Agreement between Howard County, Maryland and
- 8 the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Howard County Local
- 9 3080, Council 3, AFL-CIO, the County Council approves the Conflicting Provisions, attached
- to Bill as Exhibit 2, that are in conflict with the provisions of Title 1 "Human Resources" of
- 11 the Howard County Code or the Employee Manual.

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- 13 Section 4. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland
- 14 that if there is a conflict between the Agreement attached to this Act and the Howard County
- 15 Pay Plan, the provisions contained in the Agreement shall control.

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- 17 **Section 5.** And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland
- that the provisions of this Act shall apply to the pay period that includes July 1, 2025.

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- 20 Section 6. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland
- 21 that, in accordance with Section 612 of the Howard County Charter, Section 1 and Section 2
- of this Act shall be effective immediately upon its enactment.

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- 24 Section 7. And Be It Further Enacted by the County Council of Howard County, Maryland
- 25 that, subject to Section 6, this Act shall become effective 61 days after its enactment.
