ORDER CLARIFYING SCOPE AND PROCEDURE ON REMAND

UPON CONSIDERATION of the Memorandum Opinion of the Circuit Court for Howard County dated September 2, 2025; the Joint Request for Clarification filed October 1, 2025; and the record herein, on this 3rd day of October 2025 it is **ORDERED** as follows:

- 1. The Circuit Court determined that the Petitioner is not eligible for the requested variance. This issue is resolved and will not be revisited on remand.
- 2. The Circuit Court affirmed the Board's findings under HCZR §131.0(B). These findings are final and will not be revisited on remand.
- 3. The scope of the remand is limited to the articulation of findings of fact and conclusions of law regarding whether the proposed parking garage/auditorium building and the proposed athletic field retaining wall satisfy the applicable setback requirements.
- 4. The Board will primarily rely on the existing record in BA-22-023C&V, including prior testimony, exhibits, and video-recorded proceedings. Board members may review the recorded hearing and deliberations, and conduct additional site visits as needed prior to the hearing.
- 5. No new testimony or exhibits will be accepted except for narrowly tailored technical clarifications directly related to setback measurements, right-of-way/lot line baselines, or the application of HCZR definitions necessary to complete the record on setbacks.
- 6. Any party seeking to offer such narrowly tailored technical clarifications shall file a written proffer identifying the specific clarification and its relevance to setbacks no later than October 29, 2025. Admissibility will be determined at the remand hearing.

- 7. The remand hearing shall proceed on November 13, 2025, at 6:30 p.m., limited to: (a) Board discussion of the existing record; (b) consideration of any admitted clarifying materials under item 5; and (c) adoption of explicit findings of fact and conclusions of law addressing setback compliance.
- **8.** Following the remand hearing, the Board will issue a supplemental Decision and Order consistent with the Court's mandate.

It is so ORDERED.
