DECISION AND ORDER

The Board of License Commissioners for Howard County, Maryland (the "Liquor Board"), pursuant to Rule 1.02(A) of the Liquor Board Rules and Regulations, has delegated the authority to hear and decide cases to the Alcoholic Beverage Hearing Board for Howard County, Maryland (the "Hearing Board").

On June 9, 2026, the Hearing Board heard the application of Milad Araghi (the "Applicant"), on behalf of Forever Primo, LLC t/a Go Primo's NY Pizza Company ("Go Primo's NY Pizza Company"), for a new Class B Beer and Light Wine, 7-Day on/off sale License for a 1,516 sq. ft. restaurant located at 2020 Marriottsville Road, Suite C, Marriottsville, MD 21104.

The hearing was properly advertised, and the property posted pursuant to the Alcoholic Beverages Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland. The Applicant was not represented by counsel and there were no protestants who appeared in opposition to the application.

All the documents on file were incorporated into the record by reference.

SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

Milad Araghi, 100% interest holder and proposed resident agent, was sworn in and testified before the Hearing Board.

Mr. Araghi testified that he is the owner of Go Primo's NY Pizza Company, that he has been a resident of Howard County since 2013, that he has managed and operated the business for 9 years and that he has owned it for 4 years. Mr. Araghi stated that he has maintained a clean record with no Health Department violations or customer complaints. Mr. Araghi stated that he is applying for a liquor license in order to enhance the dining experience by offering a limited but responsibly managed selection of beer and wine. Mr. Araghi stated that he runs a family-friendly pizzeria and that maintaining a community environment is important to him. Mr. Araghi stated that he is Alcohol Awareness Certified and that one other employee who serves alcohol is Alcohol Awareness Certified. Mr. Araghi stated that he is familiar with the Howard County Liquor Board Rules and Regulations. Mr. Araghi stated that serving alcohol will allow for the continued growth of his business, that customers have requested alcohol with their food, and that this is the first time he has applied for a liquor license for this establishment. Mr. Araghi stated that he estimates alcohol sales will be 10% to 15% of the total gross sales. Mr. Araghi stated that he works 50 to 60 hours a week at the restaurant and that he supports the local community by offering fundraisers and events for local schools, a church and the fire department. Mr. Araghi stated that alcohol will be stored underneath a kitchen counter and that it will not be accessible to the public. Mr. Araghi stated that there is seating for 45 people with 15 to 17 tables. Mr. Araghi stated that he has 3 employees, that 2 people are in the kitchen and that he and another employee take orders. Mr. Araghi stated that he wants to offer alcohol to go for customers to help increase sales.

Pursuant to Rule 6.13 of the Liquor Board Rules and Regulations, the Applicant waived his right to request the Liquor Board to hear the case.

Based on the evidence presented at the hearing, the Alcoholic Beverage Hearing Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Hearing Board finds that Milad Araghi (the “Applicant”), on behalf of Forever Primo, LLC t/a Go Primo’s NY Pizza Company (“Go Primo’s NY Pizza Company”), has applied for a new Class B Beer and Light Wine, 7-Day on/off sale License for a 1,516 sq. ft. restaurant located at 2020 Marriottsville Road, Suite C, Marriottsville, MD 21104.

2. The Hearing Board finds that the Applicant is a fit and proper person to hold an alcoholic beverage license.

3. The Hearing Board finds that Milad Araghi, the resident agent applicant, meets the requirements of Rules 1.10(S), 1.10(T), and 2.06 of the Liquor Board Rules and Regulations concerning resident agent qualifications.

4. The Hearing Board finds that the granting of the application is necessary for the accommodation of the public.

5. The Hearing Board finds that the granting of the application will not unduly disturb the peace and safety of the residents of the neighborhood.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Hearing Board concludes that Milad Araghi (the “Applicant”), on behalf of Forever Primo, LLC t/a Go Primo’s NY Pizza Company (“Go Primo’s NY Pizza Company”), has applied for a new Class B Beer and Light Wine, 7-Day on/off sale License for a 1,516 sq. ft. restaurant located at 2020 Marriottsville Road, Suite C, Marriottsville, MD 21104.

2. The Hearing Board concludes that the Applicant is a fit and proper person to hold an alcoholic beverage license.

3. The Hearing Board concludes that Milad Araghi, the resident agent applicant, meets the requirements of Rules 1.10(S), 1.10(T), and 2.06 of the Liquor Board Rules and Regulations

concerning resident agent qualifications.

4. The Hearing Board concludes that the granting of the application is necessary for the accommodation of the public.

5. The Hearing Board concludes that the granting of the application will not unduly disturb the peace and safety of the residents of the neighborhood.

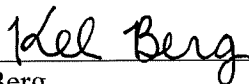
ORDER

For the foregoing reasons, it is this 29th day of July, 2026, by the Alcoholic Beverage Hearing Board of Howard County **ORDERED** that the application of Milad Araghi (the "Applicant"), on behalf of Forever Primo, LLC t/a Go Primo's NY Pizza Company ("Go Primo's NY Pizza Company"), for a new Class B Beer and Light Wine, 7-Day on/off sale License for a 1,516 sq. ft. restaurant located at 2020 Marriottsville Road, Suite C, Marriottsville, MD 21104, be and the same is hereby **GRANTED**, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) That the Applicant comply with all State and County laws and regulations;
- (b) That the Applicant satisfy any requirements necessary to obtain the license by December 9, 2026 unless that deadline is extended by the Hearing Board upon good cause shown; and
- (c) Failure to comply with these conditions shall render this Proposed Decision and Order null and void.

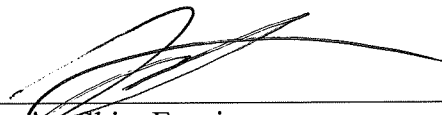
