DECISION AND ORDER

The Board of License Commissioners for Howard County, Maryland (the “Liquor Board”), pursuant to Rule 1.02(A) of the Liquor Board Rules and Regulations, has delegated the authority to hear and decide cases to the Alcoholic Beverage Hearing Board for Howard County, Maryland (the “Hearing Board”).

On February 22, 2022, the Hearing Board heard the application of Mark Regal and Fatih Eryigit (the “Applicants”), on behalf of 9400 Snowden River, LLC, t/a Homeslyce Pizza Bar (“Homeslyce”), for a reduction of premises for a Class B, Beer, Wine and Liquor 7-Day License for a 3,000 sq. ft. restaurant located at 9400 Snowden River Parkway, Suites 126-127, Columbia, MD 21045.

The hearing was properly advertised, and the property posted pursuant to the Alcoholic Beverages Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland. The Applicants were represented by Abraham Hurdle, Esquire.

All the documents on file were incorporated into the record by reference.

SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

Fatih Eryigit, 90% interest holder and proposed licensee, was sworn in and testified

before the Board.

Mr. Eryigit testified that they use Suites 126, 127 and 128 and now they are giving up Suite 128. Mr. Eryigit stated he understood that once the area was reduced, he would not be allowed to sell alcohol at Suite 128.

Pursuant to Rule 6.13 of the Liquor Board Rules and Regulations, the Applicants waived their right to request the Liquor Board to hear the case.

Based on the evidence presented at the hearing, the Alcoholic Beverage Hearing Board makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Hearing Board finds that Mark Regal and Fatih Eryigit, on behalf of 9400 Snowden River, LLC, t/a Homeslyce Pizza Bar (“Homeslyce”), have applied for a reduction of premises for a Class B, Beer, Wine and Liquor 7-Day License for a 3,000 sq. ft. restaurant located at 9400 Snowden River Parkway, Suites 126-127, Columbia, MD 21045.
2. The Hearing Board finds that the Applicants are fit and proper persons to hold an alcoholic beverage license.
3. The Hearing Board finds that Mark Regal, the resident agent applicant, meets the requirements of Rules 1.10(S), 1.10(T), and 2.06 of the Liquor Board Rules and Regulations concerning resident agent qualifications.
4. The Hearing Board finds that the granting of the application is necessary for the accommodation of the public.
5. The Hearing Board finds that the granting of the application will not unduly disturb the peace and safety of the residents of the neighborhood.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Hearing Board concludes that Mark Regal and Fatih Eryigit, on behalf of 9400 Snowden River, LLC, t/a Homeslyce Pizza Bar (“Homeslyce”), have applied for a reduction of premises for a Class B, Beer, Wine and Liquor 7-Day License for a 3,000 sq. ft. restaurant located at 9400 Snowden River Parkway, Suites 126-127, Columbia, MD 21045.

2. The Hearing Board concludes that the Applicants are fit and proper persons to hold an alcoholic beverage license.

3. The Hearing Board concludes that Mark Regal, the resident agent applicant, meets the requirements of Rules 1.10(S), 1.10(T), and 2.06 of the Liquor Board Rules and Regulations concerning resident agent qualifications.

4. The Hearing Board concludes that the granting of the application is necessary for the accommodation of the public.

5. The Hearing Board concludes that the granting of the application will not unduly disturb the peace and safety of the residents of the neighborhood.

ORDER

For the foregoing reasons, it is this 8th day of April, 2022, by the Alcoholic Beverage Hearing Board of Howard County **ORDERED** that the application of Mark Regal and Fatih Eryigit, on behalf of 9400 Snowden River, LLC, t/a Homeslyce Pizza Bar (“Homeslyce”), for a reduction of premises for a Class B, Beer, Wine and Liquor 7-Day License for a 3,000 sq. ft. restaurant located at 9400 Snowden River Parkway, Suites 126-127, Columbia, MD 21045, be and the same is hereby **GRANTED**, subject to the following conditions:

(a) That the Applicants comply with all State and County laws and regulations;


(b) That the Applicants satisfy any requirements necessary to obtain the license by

August 22, 2022 unless that deadline is extended by the Board upon good cause shown;

- (c) That the Applicants supply missing landlord documents; and
- (d) Failure to comply with these conditions shall render this Proposed Decision and Order null and void.


